



CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY – WEEK OF MAY 6, 2013 (As of 5/03/13 – subject to change without notice)

UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES:

- ❖ Major Activity – Contractor will begin moving equipment in during the week of May 6 and will begin setting up signs for Fountain Street detour.
- ❖ Major Activity - Fountain Street from Broadway Avenue to Washington Avenue will be closed to traffic on Wednesday, May 8th. Broadway Avenue from Fountain Street to Water Street will be closed to traffic and parking on Wednesday, May 8th.
- ❖ Major Activity – Removal of the existing street pavement on Fountain Street and on Broadway Avenue from Fountain Street to Water Street is expected to begin on Thursday, May 9th.

WORK HOURS:

- ❖ Work Hours – Crews are expected to work the following schedule this week (weather permitting):
 - Monday – Friday; 7 AM to 7 PM
 - Saturday – no work scheduled

PARKING RESTRICTIONS:

- ❖ No on-street parking in the following areas:
 - Fountain Street from Broadway Avenue to Washington Avenue
 - Broadway Avenue from Fountain Street to Water Street

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS RESTRICTIONS:

- ❖ All sidewalks along Broadway Avenue and all business accesses will remain open

INTERRUPTION OF WATER OR SEWER SERVICE

- ❖ No scheduled interruption of water or sewer during the week of May 6th.

ONGOING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- ❖ Stage 1 construction (Fountain Street and Broadway Avenue from Fountain Street to Water Street is expected to continue through the end of June and reopen to traffic on or before the 4th of July.
- ❖ Work on Stage 2 (Broadway Avenue from Water Street to Clark Street) is expected to begin around the first week in June.

- ❖ Held every Wednesday mornings at 9:30 a.m. at the project construction office in the Freeborn Bank Building at 201 Broadway Avenue
- ❖ Issues and questions from property owners or business attendees will be first item on the agenda
