

CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY - WEEK OF OCTOBER 7, 2013

(As of 10/04/13 – subject to change without notice)

PROGRESS SLOWED DUE TO RAIN:

- Up until recently, the weather has been very cooperative and, in general, construction has progressed without significant delays due to rain
- The rain on Wednesday night, Thursday and Friday resulted in construction being shut down the latter part of the week, and progress of some of the work was delayed

UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES:

- The construction of the decorative sidewalk accent paver areas along Broadway Avenue and on William Street east of Broadway Avenue has been completed
- ❖ The placement of concrete street pavement on Broadway Avenue has been started, and was scheduled to be completed by the middle of the week of October 7th. However, due to the rain, the concrete pavement construction will continue until at least the end of the week
- ❖ Work in Fountain Lake Park will continue with the construction of sidewalks, plaza area, stairs and terraced seating.
- Work in the north parking lot (NW corner of Broadway Avenue and Water Street) will continue for several more weeks

WORK HOURS:

- Work Hours Crews are expected to work the following schedule this week (weather permitting):
 - o Monday Friday: 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - Crews are scheduled to work on Saturday
 - No work on Sunday

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS RESTRICTIONS:

- The sidewalks along Broadway Avenue between William Street and Main Street and on William Street east of Broadway Avenue will remain open while the work in the street continues
- Business owners will be notified in advance with details of any scheduled interruptions in access to your buildings.

INTERRUPTION OF WATER OR SEWER SERVICE

All watermain and sewer construction has been completed, so there should be no further interruption of water or sewer service.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS:


- ❖ The block of Broadway Avenue between William Street and Main Street, and William Street east of Broadway Avenue will remain closed to on-street parking until mid-October.
- ❖ The 2-hour parking limit will continue to be enforced on all <u>on-street</u> parking in the downtown areas, including the portions of Broadway Avenue and William Street that have been opened.

- Two-hour parking will also be posted and enforced in a portion of the following parking lots (see map below):
 - First two rows of parking stalls in the lot located east of the alley east of Broadway Avenue between Clark Street and William Street
 - First two rows of parking stalls adjacent to the alley in the gravel lot behind Freeborn Bank Building



- The City will continue to monitor the other downtown municipal public parking lots and will make adjustments to parking limits and enforcement as required.
- The north parking lot will remain closed for several more weeks as the reconstruction of the lot continues.

ONGOING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- ❖ Work on the block from Main Street to William Street and on William Street east of Broadway Avenue is scheduled to continue into the week of approximately October 14th
- ❖ Work in Fountain Lake Park and the north parking lot will continue through mid-October. .

WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION MEETINGS

- Held every Wednesday mornings at 9:00 a.m.at the project construction office in the Freeborn Bank Building at 201 Broadway Avenue.
- Issues and questions from property owners or business attendees will be first item on the agenda.
